BELLA

Mom, I just want you to see how hard I work. Cheerleading is everything to me. When I'm yelling, "Go, Fight, Win!" I don't just mean it for our team. It's my life motto! Wherever I "go", I will "fight", until I "win"... at life!

Role: Cheerleader

Description: Girlfriend confronted by a detective on the street about fiancé's involvement in a murder.

ROSA

Whoa. Wait a minute. My Bobby had nothing to do with that skank getting murdered. It could've been a hundred other guys or some guy's jealous girlfriend. Who knows? I just know it wasn't him. He was with me all last night. So, go look elsewhere.

Role: Girlfriend

Description: School jock gives bad dating advice

BRIAN

Dude. Here's what you do. You ignore her, and then one day, outta nowhere, you act like she's "all that." She won't know what hit her, and she'll be eatin' out of your hand. Yeah, I know a thing or two about the ladies.

Role: Best Friend

Description: Athlete is upset she didn't make Varsity

CHELSEA 2

How could this happen?
I... I have to be on Varsity. I've been practicing and practicing and... this is just impossible. I'm the best in the school. Oh, God... now I have to tell my Dad I didn't make it. Brace yourself, Kel.

Role: Date

Description: Doctor having secret relationship with hospital CEO attempts to inconspicuously break up with him.

DR. JULIA STEVENSOM

This is it for us, Charles. I like you. I really do, but... You run this hospital, and I need my job. People are talking. We're not as discreet as we think. And there's too much at stake if we're exposed. I've loved our time together, but... it's over.

Role: Doctor

Description: Dr. informs parents of child's diagnosis reassuring them he will use "x" procedure and fight to save the child's life.

DR. RAZZAK

Your son will require thoracoscopic surgery to treat the collapsed lung. We need to see inside the chest cavity to make surgical repairs around the heart. Now it is less invasive than open-chest surgery, but... Mr. Miller? Look, he's not out of the woods just yet, but we're doing all we can, okay?

Role: young college graduate stuck living at home

Description: Tommy tells his girlfriend that he knows that she cheated on him.

TOMMY

I trusted you and the first chance you had, you betrayed me. Don't deny it either, Liza, because I saw you. I saw you in his arms, and I see the way you look at him. My only question is why stay with me? If he's so perfect for you, then just let me go.

Role: Boyfriend

Description: I had an affair with my female best friend when she was engaged but she chose to end it with me. I am still quietly in love with her. She pulls me aside at her wedding and I put on a mask of happiness.

TONY RODRIGUEZ

I don't have any more reservations about him. You both looked great up there at the altar. And I'm glad you can put what we did last month behind us. You wanted to marry him, not me. I'm happy to still be in your life. Even if it is as the loser. I'm kidding. Not. Kidding.

Role: Husband

Description: The governor's daughter talks with her therapist about the trials of a life with her family in the public eye.

ELIZABETH

I know I should be happy. I know on the outside it looks like I have it made, but being the Governor's daughter isn't all it's cracked up to be. Every aspect of my life is scrutinized by people who think they know me. Nobody knows me. All they know is that I'm the Governor's daughter.

Role: Husband

Description: Sharp, intentional, evil, smug, smooth and arrogant doctor explaining his credentials which explain why he believes he is entitled to have a God Complex.

JED HILL

I am the best in my field. I graduated with the highest honors from Johns Hopkins, and developed innovative surgery techniques that have saved millions of lives and are now taught in every medical school in this country. Even the President has me to thank for his life.

Role: Doctor or Nurse.

Description: Best friend needs help to cover up her boyfriends 'accident'

TAYLOR

Pull it together, Geri. We need to focus on dumping Michael's body, clean up my bathroom, and forget this ever happened. Since you were able to be my best friend and still screw Michael behind my back, I'm pretty sure you're good at keeping your mouth shut.

Role: Manipulative Rich Girl

Description: Doctor examines an senior and finds bruises around their neck warning their caregiver that if he finds out they're abusing the elderly client, he will have the authorities step in.

ROGER

Take this prescription downstairs and they'll take care of it. I noticed some bruises near Tony's neck when I examined him today. I'm going to give you the benefit of the doubt. Once. If I find out you're abusing him in the slightest, I won't hesitate to call adult protective services.

Role: Doctor

Description: Sweet-natured girlfriend describes to her boyfriend all the reasons she loves him.

ALICE

I'll tell you why. I love you because you make me laugh. Because you make me feel like the prettiest girl in the world without saying a word. I love that you're reliable, and loyal, and I trust you with my life. And I love that you know how to love me.

Role: Girlfriend

Description: Woman says husband who died in war was a hero

JACKIE

I was surprised when they gave me the flag. The way it felt in my hands. I wasn't expecting it to feel so... heavy. I couldn't have done it. What he did. Diving on that... that thing. A real hero.

Role: Wife

Description: A grittier Erin Brockovich fighting for justice for her daughter? Gruffly threatening physical violence against an older boy who made sexual advances to her young daughter? **Prototype:** Frances McDormand

JUSTICE FIGHTER

You're worse than the rapists you represent, counselor. Your inbred, entitled client sexually assaulted my daughter, but you assaulted her character. You willingly exposed and humiliated her on that stand because in your sick little mind winning trumps justice. This case might be over, but you and I are just getting started.

Role: Mother

Description: Blair is tantalizing and lying to the Lead Detective to get out of murder .

BLAIR

I've been called many things, but Murderess was not one of them. Until you came along, Detective. They WILL be gentle with me up there all alone on the stand, won't they? Aren't you nervous being here alone with me? Suppose I try to kill you? My bad. I meant to say KISS you.

Role: College Student

Description: Girl being confronted by a parent about her suspected neurosis .

SARA

It's really none of your business what I do with my body, Mom. It's mine. It's the only thing in this life that I really own and control. If I feel like cutting it, I will. So why don't you go drink your vodka and leave me alone, ok?

Role: Girl next door, intelligent, bit quirky

Description: A spoiled rich college girl is questioned about her friend's death after a frat party.

BRITNEY

Gina was destined to be that tragic friend. Total party girl. I'm really not surprised she ended up dead. No one is. Live fast, die young. Coke. Speed. If it kept the party going, she took it. She thought she could hang with the big girls.

Role: Manipulative Rich Girl

Description: Jerky jock picks on a nerd

CHRISTOPHER

Wow, who cuts your hair, Pickens? A blind guy? Or maybe that's the new look... bad hair equals cool. Ha! Nice Polo... what is this, 1986? Ya know, Pickens, if I ever decide to be a nerd, I'm coming to you for advice first.

Role: Bartender

Description: Girl decides she wants to pursue a romantic relationship with co-worker

SARAH

So, Jim, I'm off work now and I don't really have to be anywhere. Not that I'm not popular, I am, trust me, but I am free tonight if you, when you get off work, want to say go get something to eat. Not here. Somewhere else. Cuz, that would be dumb.

Role: Romantic Lead

Description: In a lab or classroom, talking to student or peer about new human genome genetics advancements and possibilities - with a little humor with it - fun show.

PROFESSOR VALENTINE

It doesn't just stop with major genetic defects like disease. This could be a complete cosmetic genetic enhancer. We can fix all genetic shortcomings: balding, predisposition to acne or weight gain, small breasts, unfortunately small... other things...

Role: New Girl, Underdog

Description: Detective wants to get the guy who murdered his best friend

DET.

OWEN

Come on, Karl, my gut's telling me that this is our guy. Jimmy was my best friend, and before he got shot, I could sense the tension between him and Reese. The guy's got priors and motive, so let me bring him in. Please. Jimmy's family needs this more than I do.

Role: Server

Description: Prosecutor makes closing argument of her life regarding sex offender - because this time, it's personal.

MARSHA

My client asked for it. Short skirts. Low cut tops. Did I ask for it too? To be gang raped in my dorm room while I tried to scream for help but couldn't because of the paralysis from the roofies? It was my short skirt's fault, correct? Skirts don't cause rape. My client is a victim. And she will be scarred for life. Just like I was.

Role: Prosecutor

Description: A senator is approached by a senate colleague who offers her a committee chairmanship in exchange her vote on a crucial piece of legislation.

SENATOR ROUNTREE

I see your point on the climate change bill, Senator Ross. And it sounds intriguing. But you missed one thing. I'm holding the GOP responsible for reducing corporate greenhouse gas emissions. Our future relies on this bill. And I will hold them, and you, accountable until it passes.

Role: Drug Dealer

Description: I am pointing a gun and confronting someone that threatened to kill one of my family members. If he ever dares to come close to my family again, I will not hesitate to kill him.

ALEX

I'm almost in. This firewall is complicated. Once I'm in, it will search for us, so we only have a couple of seconds. Okay. Now! I've got it. These are the names of all the people Reese has turned over to the government. Jesus. No way. That's... that's my name. He gave them my name.

Role: SPY / SECRET AGENT

Description: Josh talks to his date at dinner about how he believes in soul mates and how when you know you've found the right person, you just know.

JOSH

Romeo had Juliet. King Kong had Fay Wray. I have you. Let me order for us both, or you can go ahead and order. I know you know what I want. And I know what YOU want. We were meant to be one. How do I know? You know. I know you know. See? You don't even have to talk. Shh. I know.

Role: Bar Patron

Description: Undercover detective

DANIELLE

I gotta do it, Jack. Women are his only weakness. He's not going to confess to the Feds, but one romantic dinner with Lora Von Vlassyk, he will tell all. No?

Role: Funeral Director

Description: Sociopath has the guy who tried to rape and kill her little sister tied up and is about to kill him.

NORAH

I've seen that look before. That's the look my little sister had the night you tried to rape and kill her. Sheer terror looks better on YOU. My sister doesn't know I have you all tied up and vulnerable. If she did, she'd insist I let you go. She's a kind heart. Any last words?

Role: Detective

Description: Daughter who is in hospital tells her mother that the thing she fears the most is leaving her little brother without a sister

MAUREEN

I'm not scared anymore, Mom. I'll make the best out of the little time I have left. I only worry about how Jack is going to take the news. He's only six years old. No boy at his age should have to say goodbye to his big sister. It just isn't fair.

Role: Daughter

Description: Interrogation scene for Marsha's daughter

MARCELA

First I saw him talking to, you know, the lady, the dead lady. They looked like they were arguing. You know, like how my mom and dad do it. He grabbed her by the arm, and pulled her close. I didn't actually see him stab her, but I saw the knife after and it had blood on it.

Role: Office Worker

Description: A well-liked teacher pleads to class to give up the student who stole an office laptop, then goes on with lesson when no one steps up.

LORRAINE DOGGET

I know the person that stole my laptop is sitting in this classroom right now. I also know there's an honest person who saw it happen that wants to speak up but is afraid to for one reason or another. Don't be. Ok. Not today, I suppose. Open to page 45.

Role: Teacher

Description: Secretary says married boss is perfect for her

JANE FRYMAN

He's perfect, Jeanie.
Perfect for me. Why
would I be given this
opportunity for true
love if it wasn't meant
to be? Yes, he's my
boss. Yes, he's
married. But it just
feels right. And I know
he has feelings for me,
too.

Role: Secretary

Description: A detective tries to get a gangbanger to rat out one of this boys for killing his old lady.

BROCK

Look, I ain't saying
your old lady didn't
need to get got. Maybe
she couldn't keep her
mouth shut. But you
don't roll on the one of
your boys who did it?
I'm looking at you for
it. Believe that.
That's the needle,
homes. You ready for
that?

Role: Son

Description: a brother having to admit to his mother that his brother did something illegal

GABRIEL

Mom, I have to tell you
something, but you have
to promise me you won't
get mad or call the
cops. I'm pretty sure
Davey's been dealing
drugs. I found his
stash and... and a
bunch of
paraphernalia... so
he's using, too. I
think we should confront
him.

Role: Son

Description: College student initially telling his ex that he is over her, only to then tell her that he really isn't.

KALEB

We're done! I'm over
it, Jess. I'm over you.
It wasn't right from the
start, so let's just
call it quits and...
Look, I can't lie
anymore. I'm not over
you. And I can't just
have you as a friend. I
love you, Jess, I really
just need some space for
a while, ok?

Role: College Student

Description: Agent negotiates hostage trade-off

RAY

My only objective is to reclaim the team member you're holding hostage. If you're ready to make a deal, I think both of us can get back something valuable. Nikolai, my snipers are everywhere. Don't double-cross me.

Role: TBD

Description: Delivering an important secret message in the night.

SANSA

My father requests your presence prior to the new moon to discuss our mutual enemy at our kingdom's borders. I suggest abiding his wishes and dashing your petty squabble to focus on this dire attack. You shall also show a little respect by calling him by his proper title: Your Lord.

Role: Lady of the Court

Description: Detective interrogates suspect.

MITCHELL

Of course. You were with a stripper whose name you don't know, from a strip club you can't give us the name of because you were too drunk to remember. Maybe you have amnesia, too. Playing games with me is not a wise idea. I never lose.

Role: Office Worker

Description: Jennifer was told to interrogate her work partner who also is her childhood best friend who's being accused of murdering their boss.

JENNIFER

Look, this is awkward for both of us. I haven't seen you since we were BFFs in Mrs. Brown's 6th grade class, and now I have to interrogate you for murder. I'm really sorry, Kim. I need to know where you were the night of the murder and I'll need an alibi.

Role: FBI Agent

Description: Young girl begs her father to not sell her horse, which he needs to do to pay the mortgage on the family farm.

LUCY

You can't sell Chester, Dad. I've almost got him broken, and I know he's got the heart of a winner. Look, I know things are tight, and you have to pay the mortgage, but in the meantime, Chester can help on the farm. This is where he belongs. Please, Daddy.

Role: Daughter

Description: Guy is asking his girlfriend to trust him and that they will get out of the house and escape from the serial killer, who is after them, and that tomorrow they will be eating pancakes and this will seem like a bad nightmare.

PETER

Stop crying. He'll hear you. Listen to me, Robin. This maniac is not going to find us if we keep our heads. When he enters the room, you make a run for the window. I will follow, I swear. And tomorrow we'll be eating pancakes and this will all seem like a really terrible nightmare. Okay?

Role: Newly single mom

Description: Double agent is being interrogated - she can be good or bad as long as she's badass.

SAMANTHA

As a field agent, I have served this country, risked my life, sacrificed more than you will ever know, and you have the gall to accuse me of selling classified nuclear information to Iraq? I've felt nothing but loyalty to the US... until this very moment.

Role: Best Friend

Description: Suspect pleading her case that she is not involved in the disappearance of her boyfriend.

JOAN

We were fighting, but nothing serious. It was just arguing. I tripped over the ottoman again, that's what they heard downstairs. I didn't report him missing because, like I said, we were arguing. It's not unusual for him to not call me when he's cooling off.

Role: Suspect

Description: Reluctant witness being questioned by police, who are trying to indict her boyfriend.

NORA

He mentioned the Castaneda family, but he never involved me in any of his business dealings, Officer. He was very secretive, but I never suspected it was because he was doing anything illegal. That's just who he is. I... I'm afraid I can't help you.

Role: Mother

Description: Caring teacher gives pep to talk to student who doesn't think he is good enough.

GRACE

What you did in class today... that was right up there with Brando and Pacino. Powerful. I know your family wants you to go the academia route, but... I encourage you to explore this talent. You have the potential to be one of the greats. Follow your heart, Matthew.

Role: Teacher

Description: A woman relishing her freedom after being with the wrong man and having his child.

KAREN

I understand now. I understand why God saved me when I almost died giving birth to our son. I have a bigger purpose in this life. All you did was teach me hate. You turned me into someone I didn't even recognize. And you leaving us was the second time God saved me.

Role: Mother

Description: Similar sample on your site with the Judge telling sounselor to cut the theatrics. Judge is sort of a bitch and pissed off to begin with that she has to hear a stupid case.

STACEY GARRETT

Enough of the theatrics, Counselor. You're not just wasting my time, but the time of the good citizens in the jury box. One more outburst like that and I'll hold you in contempt. It's bad enough that this case borders on frivolous. Don't push me.

Role: Office Worker

Description: Claire is straight out of law school and she has just tried her very first case, a murder case, and lost.

CLAIRE

I understand that it was my first case but... she only testified because she believed in me. And I failed. A violent rapist is back on the streets and she will never see the justice that I so boldly promised her. I know you believe in me, Frank.. but how can I continue practicing law if I don't believe in myself?

Role: Lawyer

Description: Strong, yet vulnerable mentor imparts his experience and wisdom. Robin Williams or Morgan Freeman type.

SIMON

I don't have the answers you seek. You'll find them all within yourself. In the quiet moments. In the desperate, gnawing moments that separate the men from the boys. Sit with that discomfort, bathe in it, knowing it will show you the way better than any other can.

Role: Mentor

Description: Sexy upperclass girl who is a witness to a crime and now is being sought after because she witnessed a crime - possibly a murder or a robbery... needs protection from police.

JESSICA

My massage went late and there was no one in the parking garage. I got out of the elevator, and I heard a woman scream and then a POP! I must have screamed, too, because he saw me. And he starting coming after me so I got back in the elevator and came here. Please help me.

Role: Romantic Lead

Description: A widow contemplates life without her husband

EVANGELINA

How do I go on without him, Mariella? He was the love of my life. My best friend. We had the perfect life. It was so amazing to wake up by his side. I was always hopeful that he would come out of the coma... I never expected him to... We were talking about starting a family. I don't know who I am without him.

Role: Wife

Description: A young mother pleads to regain custody of her kids in foster care.

CLARA

Look, I know I haven't been the best mother, in the last year and a half, but that's changed. I've changed. I've gotten my stuff together and I am ready to be the mother I was meant to be. For my kids. Please, give me that chance.

Role: Teacher

Description: Cystic Fybrois teen tells girlfriend she makes him feel special

MICHAEL

Cystic Fybrois. I was afraid that if I told you, you would treat me differently. I just... I've always just wanted to be like everyone else. Funny thing is... you make me feel special, Anna. Turns out I like that more.

Role: Bartender

Description: A doctor gives some difficult news to little girls parents.

ROBERT

Katy came through the procedure fine, but there were some complications. She's resting comfortably now. However...the infection is very aggressive and her immune system is very close to compromised. I'd stay the night if I were you. Just in case.

Role: Nurse

Description: With a half-street half-ivy league pitch, bright-eyed bushy-tailed crack neurosurgeon tries to convince one of the founding partners of a small but upscale practice to hire her.

MAYA

I know I'm fresh out of med school, but I'm a perfect fit for your practice, Dr. Rush. Come on, Ivy League aside, you and I come from the same hood. Chicago, south side, bro. I can assure you my education speaks for itself, and I'm a damn good neurosurgeon.

Role: Girl Next Door

Description: I am trying to convince my colleague to let me conduct a tricky surgery because my way will work.

SARAH

Dr. Lynch, I'm certain my approach will be not only faster, but much more effective. I'm not saying your way is wrong. I'm only asking for you to give me a chance. You brought me to St. Luke's to introduce fresh points of view. Well, now is your chance to let me do just that.

Role: SURGEON

Description: Younger brother telling big sister how he plans to run away because dad yelled at him.

JAVIER

I know how I'm going to do it. I'll just pack up my pajamas and my favorite book, and I'll sneak out of the house when Mom and Dad are asleep. You can't tell them where I'm going. Maybe then Dad will realize he can't keep yelling at me.

Role: Best Friend

Description: Dad tells PTA they have to follow the rules

RICHARD 2

You're a PTA member just like me. Just like her. We're not the Principal or the Superintendent. We're parents. We can't just arbitrarily start enforcing a policy like that because it's right - there are protocols and procedures. I don't like it either, but there are rules, Marty.

Role: New Role

Description: A female cop is interviewing a murder suspect in an interview room at the precinct.

THERESE

You found out she was sleeping with your best friend, so you murdered her. And you still had access to her apartment and knew her schedule. That's what we call motive, means and opportunity. Please. Make this interesting for me and tell me you have an alibi.

Role: High School Student

Description: Coolest guy in the group but at the same time he's a trouble maker.

MARK

Look, buddy, all I'm saying is if you knew what you were doing with the ladies, you'd be... well, more like me. And don't let that punk Miguel talk to you like he does. You're better than that, and you deserve more respect. Now, go get me a drink and I'll tell you the meaning of life.

Role: New Role

Description: Intern tells critical attending his negative comments are not helping her become a better doctor and he needs to take a step back.

JUDY

With all due respect, Doctor, your teaching style sucks. I don't take my career lightly, and I expect to be taught with professionalism and respect. Maybe you're not used to strong, smart women, but I can assure you I'm not going anywhere. Back off.

Role: Date

Description: Macey, has a terminal illness. She is telling her husband she wants to take the suicide pill while she is still strong, so that he and their child will only have memories of her happy and healthy, and so they can move on.

MACEY

I don't expect you to be on board with this right now. But I won't have my son see me as a skinny, struggling, awful version of myself that will haunt his dreams and cloud any happy memories we had. Same for you. I want you to remember me as this. Strong. Fighting. I'm taking that pill.

Role: Girlfriend

Description: Upon being asked to leave the group, Sean professes his love to a female group member and tries convincing her to come with him.

SEAN

I've tried reasoning with Rick, but he's losing it. He wants me out. His paranoia is more of a threat to this group's safety than the walkers outside. Come with me, Jessie. I know how to make it safely to the Citadel. But without you... what's the point?

Role: Survivor

Description: A determined but principled investment banker explains to his very determined and somewhat unscrupulous boss the best and most legal way to invest company and personal assets.

WILLIAM

Every day, we balance risk and reward. Wait for the walk sign, or sprint across the street? Yes, holding more capital and lower-yielding liquid assets will depress returns. We need to limit our leverage to sane levels. Perhaps I can help you navigate some of those new regulations.

Role: Nemesis

Description: Girlfriend talking to Ex-Boyfriend

KRISTINA

When you broke up with me, I didn't just lose the love of my life. I lost my best friend. And now you pop back into my life the second I find someone special? Greg, don't you see? You're not in love with me. You're in love with the challenge.

Role: Girlfriend

Description: Drug rehab counselor and former addict tells a patient she will die if she doesn't stop using.

MYA

I've been where you are and it's brutal. Like you can't do enough Oxy to numb the pain of living. I get that. I was that. You want to feel physically what you feel emotionally. Which is dead. And, trust me: That's where you're headed.

Role: Slacker

Description: Nurse reassures grieving family member

ALICIA

It's okay to be angry. No one deserves to die like she did. But now she feels no pain, Mr. Hawthorn. And when your anger passes and your healing begins, you'll forget how much she suffered and remember how much she loved you.

Role: Nurse

Description: Lawyer convinces other lawyer to help client.

TYLER

Terry White is not a child abuser. She is a hard-working single mom with a dependency problem. I know people get divorced every single day and they don't end up alcoholics, but... Jerry. She's not strong like us. She needs our help.

Role: Wife

Description: Older, seasoned detective trying to protect his job knowing his younger aggressive partner is trying to get him fired

DIRK FOSTER

You think being a hot shot is gonna get you in good with the Chief? You don't think he can smell punks like you a mile away? Listen to me. I've been working this beat since you were soiling your diapers. If you try to throw me under the bus, I'm taking you with.

Role: Detective

Description: Amy rants about being cheated on , while ridiculously self medicating with alcohol. Not drunk yet, but aiming for it.

AMY

All they ever do is cheat on us and give us zero orgasms. And Josh was no exception. YES, WE WERE DATING.

Role: Dad

Description: A suspect defends himself in an interrogation against charges he murdered his own child.

CHARLES

There's no way I could've killed my son. That boy was my world. And everything bad I ever did in my life was wiped clean the day I had him. I don't care what you think I did, nothing will ever change that. Nothing.

Role: Man Pleading Innocence

Description: Office worker shows mock sympathy for co-worker passed over for a promotion

LARRY

Hey buddy, real bummer about that promotion. If you keep working hard I'm sure you'll get the next one. But, I guess that means you'll be reporting to "the kraken" after all. Haha! The Krac-a-lackin. El kracko. Ex-kractumundo. Giant Krack! She's right behind me isn't she.

Role: Reporter

Description: A mean high school bully, leader of mean girls bad mouthing another girl and threatening her friends not to hang out with the other girl and giving them an ultimatum.

NORA

Nice? She's not nice. No one's that nice. She's a fake. I'm not buying it and neither should you guys. No... I bet she's got some kind of plan to take us down. That's it, you are all forbidden to speak with her. If you do, find some new friends.

Role: High school bully

Role: Daughter

Description: Girl tells her dad that her boyfriend makes her laugh and he's a good guy

CARRIE

 laugh. Just like you
 used to make Mom laugh.
 I want that life too,
 Daddy. I want to grow
 old with him, and I want
 you to be happy for us.

Role: Daughter

Description: An Elite high ranking soldier discovers the ugly truth that her brother is part of the faction she is charged to neutralize with any means at her disposal, and she chooses her duty over family.

BENTON

You? You're part of the Halcyon Faction? How do you think that's going to reflect on me - my very own brother is part of the organization I'm commissioned to eliminate? I wish you would have told me, Xavier. We could have worked something out, but now... you leave me no choice.

Role: Military

Description: DRACO, an ancient vampire has awoken in modern times only to find out that vampires and werewolves live peacefully amongst each other.

DRACO

THIS IS UNHOLY.
Vampires and werewolves are sworn enemies who enjoy being sworn enemies. It gives each of our sides purpose!!
THIS ENDS NOW, AND STARTS AGAIN. War. We fight. For our territory and our right to overpower their kind. Peace time is over. GET UP.

Role: Vampire

Description: A young, powerful witch is threatening to destroy another rising witch.

EVALYNN

You messed with the wrong witch, Vanessa. You're on my radar now, so you better watch your back. If I even hear that you have been in my neighborhood, picking dandelions at the park, or even walking by a cat ... Seriously, one false move and you won't know what hit you.

Role: College Student

Description: Girl begs her parents to give her one last chance after admitting how drugs have caused her to screw up her life.

ZOE

Role: Teacher

Description: Moving away from childhood home to an unknown place without friends.

MORGAN

Apparently my Mom's job is taking her to somewhere in Italy. I don't want to move to Italy! I don't speak Italian and neither does she! How am I supposed to make new friends if we don't even speak the same language. Promise you won't forget about me.

Role: Trailer Park Lady

Description: Incarcerated drug addict pleads with his younger brother not to follow in his footsteps and to make a better life for himself and his family.

RICK

Listen to me, Mikey. Don't do what I did. I messed up, okay? I thought I was smarter than the law, and too smart to get addicted, but I wasn't. I'm a junkie. See me for who I am, and be better... for yourself, for your family, and for Mom and Dad. You hear me?

Role: Older Brother

Description: Devious, spoiled and arrogant young man is cross-examined for the rape and murder of a fellow college student.

CHAD

Yes, Carly Martin was a beautiful girl, and yes, she recently broke up with me. I would never have murdered her out of spite or revenge. There are many other beautiful girls on campus, and most of them would give their little finger for me to even know they exist.

Role: Upperclass Man

Description: Will tells his lover why he can't be with her and why he won't love her back.

WILL

It really has been fun, Susanna. We were good together for awhile, but I never meant it to be more than just a summer fling. It just wouldn't be fair to you to keep you hanging on. I know in my heart that I could never love you the way you deserve to be loved.

Role: Friend xxx

Description: A beautiful woman always being overlooked at work and not taken seriously due to her appearance. She assertively talks to her boss that she deserves this promotion and is equally qualified as her male counterpart.

LISA PARKS

No disrespect, sir, but I've been here twice as long as Kyle. I'm efficient, I'm effective, and I know how to connect with clients. That junior partner promotion should have gone to me. I'm more than qualified and you know it, Andrew. I trust you'll make this right.

ASHLEY

You knew exactly what you were doing, Rachel. People don't do things when they're drunk that they wouldn't do when they're sober. You're my sorority sister. If I can't trust you with my boyfriend, then who can I trust?

Role: Girl next door, hopeless romantic

Description: Snarky Attorney, serious yet comedic. Ability to show range in 30 sec.

GINA LOVING

Well... thank you for the vote of confidence, Patrick. Since you're asking, I'm prepared to shred you and your team by winning this case. That said, I'm gonna be a little busy tonight... dinner's off. See you Saturday at 7. Wear that sport coat I like.

Role: Lawyer

Description: Doctor tells patient that he is terminal

DR.

PARKS

Role: Dancer

Role: Best Friend

Description: Daughter has heart to heart with dad over her not ever feeling like he makes her feel worthy and never being around for Christmas.

LISA

I know you're busy, Dad, but... you're never here. Christmas, my birthday... I feel like you don't make the effort to see me. If I never made an effort to see friends who live two blocks away from me, we'd never see each other. I just want to feel like I'm worth it to you.

Role: Con Artist

Description: Lawyer asks why banks got bailout but not client

Role: Lawyer

Role: Criminal
